Press conference on the International High-Rise Award 2022/23 – Announcement of the winner

Ladies and Gentlemen,

For the tenth time, the City of Frankfurt, Deutsches Architekturmuseum (DAM) and DekaBank are bestowing the International High-rRse Award (IHA), which entails prize money of 50,000 euros.

The official announcement of the IHA winner and the prize-giving ceremony will take place on the evening of 8 November 2022 in the Paulskirche in Frankfurt and via livestream.


